## Faith over Fear



“Master, Master we’re going to drown!” This was the desperate plea of the disciples when they were in the midst of a storm on the boat with Jesus. These experienced fishermen and sailors had seen a storm or two in their days, but this one was bigger. This one was unpredictable. This one, they thought, was going to be the one to do them in. They were scared. Their fear was at a high level, and their faith was nowhere to be found.

Jesus gets up and rebukes the storm, but He also gives His disciples a rebuke as well, “Where is your faith?” They didn’t understand who was in the boat with them. They didn’t understand the power that Jesus had within Him. We ought not to make the same mistake today.

We are in the midst of a difficult storm. It is very unpredictable; we don’t know what the future will hold. We don’t know what next week will even look like. It may cause our fear to shoot up. Now, having faith in God does not mean that we or anyone we love won’t become infected or even lose their life because of this virus, but it does mean that we are not alone.

God is bigger than any fear and difficulty that can come our way. Nothing surprises Him and nothing we’re going through is too hard for Him to face. In the midst of the storm is the time to exercise our faith. Now is the time to stand and say, “God, I am afraid, I don’t know what’s going to happen, but I will trust you. I will hold on to you.” Put your hope in the one who sees the whole picture. He is with us.

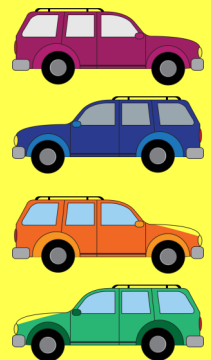
